KETUT'S STORY

Ketut comes from a family of woodcarvers who eke out a living in the highly competitive handicrafts cottage industry in Bali. The children have to help out with the family's work each day, and the parents struggle to find the money to keep them all at school.

In the current economic downturn in Bali, there are many families in a similar situation who are too poor to keep their children in school. As a result, many children are being withdrawn from school and miss out on the opportunity to improve their lives, thus perpetuating the poverty cycle of their parents.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

Your donation to the Education Assistance Program will help a child like Ketut.

Our Education Assistance team locates children in need in villages in poor areas in Bali, and the program uses your donation to assist with school expenses such as clothing, books and other requirements.

This assistance is designed to give the child a help-up in life rather than a hand-out and is intended to cover most but not all school expenses.

You can donate at three levels – Primary, Junior Secondary and Senior Secondary School. Your donation is converted to Rupiah and deposited in a village bank account by our Education Assistance Team where the interest earned is compounded over the period it is held in the bank. The family can access funds each month for school expenses from this account.

Ideally, donors will continue their assistance for the duration of the child's schooling.

Our Education Assistance team makes regular visits to the child's village to monitor the use of your funds and to provide you with updated information on your sponsored child.

If you are visiting Bali you can make arrangements through our Bali office to meet your sponsored child and his/her family with our staff.
